

## Knowledge Organiser- Spring 2 Year 6

### English-The 1000 year old boy

- Use knowledge of language from stories, plays and poetry to enhance the effectiveness of their writing
- Develop characters, settings and atmosphere using language and vocabulary from reading books
- Use a wide range of devices to build cohesion across paragraphs
- Integrate dialogue to advance action and convey character

### Science- Evolution and Inheritance

- To recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago
- To recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents
- To identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution

### Geography- North America

- To name and locate the countries of North America, including the major cities
- To know where the Equator, Tropics of Cancer, Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic Circle are on a world map
- To know what is meant by 'tropics'
- To be able to identify the position of latitude and longitude
- To know how the Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere affects day and night

### Relationship Education- Media in our everyday lives

- How the media, including online experiences, can affect people's wellbeing- their thoughts, feelings and actions
- That not everything should be shared online or social media and that there are rules about this

### D.T- Packaging

- To investigate packaging
- To design a package for a tortilla
- To make a package for a Maya tortilla
- To evaluate a package

### PE-Hockey

- To warm up appropriately,
- To demonstrate their individual skills
- To offer useful information for improvement with the dribble
- To offer useful information for improvement with the dribble, passing and receiving

### Computing-Quizzing

- To create a picture-based quiz for young children
- To learn how to use the question types within 2Quiz

- Use concrete materials or pictorial representations to show scaling up or down to find missing values e.g. 4 people eat 350g of pasta, how much pasta is needed for 12 people?
- Interpret pie charts and use these to solve problems
- Know that the perimeter of a circle is called the circumference
- Know that a straight line from one point on the edge of a circle to another point on the edge that passes through the centre is called the diameter
- Know that a straight line from the centre of a circle to the edge is called a radius

- Racism: what is it, and why is it unfair?
- To learn from the stories of two statues in Bristol
- To learn the Golden Rule and Silver Rule: what are they, and why are these rules found in so many religions?
- How can I express my own vision for justice and equality?

- Can I use secondary compass points?
- Can I describe locations of countries in Europe?
