SCHOOL UNIFORM

School uniform is available to order online at Brigade.uk.com

You can order at any point in the school year and it will be delivered to your home address. You are able to purchase all the products you have previously been able to buy from school at the same or a slightly cheaper cost. We have offered some items at a reduced cost in order to compensate for the cost of delivery, which is £3.95 but free on orders over £50. You may wish to order with a friend in order to receive free delivery on smaller orders.

Items such as skirts, trousers, polo shirts and PE shorts can still be purchased from your usual suppliers such as supermarkets and clothes stores. These do not have to be school branded and do not need to be purchased from Brigade. (Please refer to our school uniform policy on the website).

In addition to the items that have been available from school you can now also order an embroidered polo top. The non-embroidered tops are still standard school uniform but you may wish to buy an embroidered top for summer months when cardigans are not worn as often. This is personal choice and NOT compulsory uniform.

You can also purchase school embroidered coats, fleeces and waterproofs. Again please note that these are not compulsory school uniform but are available if you wish to purchase one.
