

English

We are reading 'SUPERTATO' by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet.

We will be writing character profiles, writing wanted posters, creating our own super hero characters and describing them, writing instructions to escape from evil pea and writing our own versions of the story.

Maths

Some of the work we will be learning in maths will be to understand money, recognising coins to £2. To recognise and know the value of £5, £10 and £20. To learn multiplication of 2's, 5's and 10's in arrays and repeat patterns. To understand division by sharing into equal parts.

Music

We will be listening and appraising songs with a Latin dance theme. We will be learning about pitch, pulse and rhythm.

Geography

We will be learning what the equator is, that hotter countries are located nearest the equator and know the coldest countries are located towards the North and South Pole.

Science

This half term we will be learning all about materials. We will learn the names of the materials an object is made from. We will explore the properties of everyday materials.

RHE

This half term is money. We will be discussing how we get money and how we need things and want things. We will think about how needs and wants are different.
