COMPUTING

This half term we will be exploring animated

stories. We will be looking at the differences

LITERACY

This half term, we will be reading the books, 'Tell me a lion story' by Kara Kramer and 'Where the Wild things are' by Maurice Sendak. Some of the writing we will be doing is to make our own stories, writing setting descriptions, imagining our own wild things and describing them and writing fact files on our creatures.

MATHS

This half term we will be learning how to answer addition and subtraction calculations with missing numbers. We will learn how to partition numbers when adding and subtracting, solve multiplication and division problems, representing and interpreting data and solving problems involving measures.



TOPIC

This half term we are learning about Africa!

We will be learning about hot and cold places in the world, learning that there are 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world. We will To locate Africa on the globe and compare the differences between Africa and the UK. We will begin to understand the culture and how people live in an African village and how this compares to their own life.

R.E

This half term we will be reading some Parable stories and the meanings behind them and the lessons that they teach us. We will be discussing good, bad and forgiveness.

RHE

Our RHE topic this half term is 'Living in the Wider World'

We will be learning how kind and unkind behaviour can affect others; how to be polite and courteous; how to play and work co-operatively.
