<p><u>English - Writing</u> In English we are going to be looking at a legend. 'The legend of the Loch Ness Monster' Research and make notes on the Loch Ness Monster. What can you find out? What sightings and stories can you find? Bring these notes in to help with your writing.</p>	<p><u>English – Reading</u> Read two types of books. One could be an adventure story and one could be a fairy-tale. One could be a novel and one could be a graphic novel. Write a comparison of the books that you have read. How are they similar? How are they different?</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Find a recipe in a cookery book or online. It could be a recipe for a cake for 4 people. Write out the ingredients and how much you need. Now write it again for double the amount of people. How much of each ingredient will you need now?</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Research the word 'inheritance'. What does the word mean in relation to our science topic of Evolution and Inheritance. Think about your family and carers. What things have you inherited from your families? Create a poster about Evolution and everything that you have learnt so far.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u> <u>North America</u> Draw and label a map of North America Research the many countries within North America and their capital cities Find out about the climate in North America and what kind of animals are living in North America.</p>	<p><u>RHE</u> Think about how the media and social media can affect peoples' lives. Create a poster for children to help them to stay safe online and to help them when viewing things in the media. Bring your finished posters into school for our class display.</p>	<p><u>D.T/Art</u></p>  <p>Plan, design and create your very own American flag. Bring these into school.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u> Research different types of quizzes online. What types of quizzes are there?
