

LITERACY

This half term we will be creating an invitation to invite the Tiger from the book *The Tiger Who Came to Tea* to a party, creating a fact file about tigers and re-writing their own story of Dave & Julie Saunders' book *The Duck's Tale*. Our writing will focus on using capitals letters, full stops, exclamation/ question marks and using 'and' to lengthen our sentences.

SCIENCE

This half term we will be investigating everyday materials and their properties. Vocabulary we will be using includes *metal, stone, rock, fabric, brick, rough, smooth*.

COMPUTING

The children will continue to work on simple coding: Predicting what will happen when looking at a simple algorithm e.g. where the turtle icon might go. Also trying to fix code if it doesn't work properly.

MATHS

We will be focusing on doubling and halving numbers up to 10, giving directions, identifying half and quarter of a shape and adding and subtracting numbers up to 2 digits. We will be using maths vocabulary to compare size, weight and capacity, and beginning to tell the time to the hour and to the nearest half an hour.



Year 1, Knowledge Organiser

RE

This half term we will be exploring both Christianity and Judaism, looking at marriage and symbols for belonging for both religions, including symbols that mean something to them.

TOPIC

We will be learning about the seasons and weather in the UK, comparing it to hot areas near the equator, and colder areas located nearer to the North and South Pole.

RHE

Our RHE topic this half term will be 'What can we do with money?' We will be discussing what money looks like, the difference between 'needs' and 'wants' and the different ways that we can keep money safe.

PE

This term our PE day will **be on a Tuesday**. Our focus will be Football, where we will be dribbling a ball, sending it to someone and receiving it with basic control.

ART

This half term we will be designing, making and evaluating our own tiger puppets.

MUSIC

We will listen to different types of music, with a focus on a Latin Bossa Nova song, called *Round and Round*, which we will learn and perform. We will be using glockenspiels to accompany this piece and clap out rhythms.
