Walkden Library

All classes from Y3-Y6 are visiting the library at Walkden Gateway during the week commencing 25th November.

Salford Road Safety Team

Christmas Events



We have been making lots of plans to ensure that Christmas in school, will be a magical and exciting time for the children. I have outlined the proposed Christmas celebrations and dates below.

Big Sing- Audacious Church

The school choir will be performing as part of the 'Big Sing 2024' at the Audacious Church in Manchester. This will be on Sunday 1st December. Members of the choir will receive detailed information around times/coach travel/ pick ups etc.

Pantomime

On 3rd December, we are taking all the KS2 children (Y3,4,5,6) to the Victoria Hall in Bolton to watch the pantomime, Aladdin. This will be a wonderful chance for our pupils to experience the joy of live theatre at Christmas time! The subsidised cost of this is a voluntary contribution of £10 per pupil. The kitchen staff will be serving Christmas lunch on 10th December. If your child is on packed lunches, they have the option of buying a Christmas lunch. The office will be sending out forms to book and pay for the lunch in advance. Alternatively, you may wish to make your child's packed lunch more festive by adding a cracker or mince pie. Children are allowed to wear a Christmas jumper instead of their school sweatshirt on this day.
