Select some books that you are interested in. Choose a topic of your choice to research. Whilst reading your book, make notes on your topic. Then create your own poster telling everyone everything that you have learnt and been reading.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b> Make some long multiplication calculations for yourself. Complete these calculations and then check your answers using the inverse.  Can you write some long division calculations and calculate too?</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b> In Science, we are learning all about our hearts. Choose an activity from the list below. Make a heart for someone special to you. Find out about some famous heart surgeons. How do you become a heart surgeon? Find out the size and structure of the human heart and compare this to animals' hearts.</p>
<p><b><u>Geography</u></b> In Geography this term, we are learning all about the water cycle and how clean water is so important to us all in our daily lives. Make some notes on why clean water is so important to us and to people all over the world.</p>	<p><b><u>RHE</u></b> Sleep is so important to us all.
